H.R. 6603, To apply foreign-direct product rules to Iran;

H.Res. 82, Expressing the sense of Congress regarding the need to designate Nigeria a Country of Particular Concern for engaging in and tolerating systematic, ongoing, and egregious violations of religious freedom, the need to appoint a Special Envoy for Nigeria and the Lake Chad region, and for other purposes;

** H.R. 7159, To bolster United States engagement with the Pacific Islands region, and for other purposes;

H.Res. 965, Calling for the immediate release of Ryan Corbett, a United States citizen, who was wrongfully detained by the Taliban on August 10, 2022, and condemning the wrongful detention of Americans by the Taliban;

H.R. 6046, To designate Ansarallah as a foreign terrorist organization and impose certain sanctions on Ansarallah, and for other purposes;

H.R. 7122, To prohibit aid that will benefit Hamas, and for other purposes; and

** H.R. 7152, To direct the Secretary of State to establish a national registry of Korean American divided families, and for other purposes.
